What is LegalPod? LegalPod is a free legal service for young people aged 17-25 transitioning from care. LegalPod is available for the duration of the your transition, as long as you would like our help.

We can help you sort out hassles with debt, fines, housing, Centrelink and other government bodies. We will also connect you with specialist services for help with family and criminal law issues.

What can LegalPod help with?

How does LegalPod work? A small team of volunteer lawyers - your LegalPod - will meet with you two or three times each year at a place where you feel safe. Your LegalPod will work with you to identify and address legal issues as they come up. You can stay in touch with your LegalPod by phone, text and email.

LegalPod is a service where you're in charge. The LegalPod will give you information and advice so you can decide what you want to do, and how we can help.

Everything you tell LegalPod is confidential. We will only take steps to help you and/or tell other people about your situation when we have your permission.

We keep records of any work we do for you for 7 years, after which time the records are destroyed. You can contact LegalPod at any time to discuss your file.
