

T2A BINGO INSTRUCTIONS



1. Use an online platform like Teams, Skype or Zoom
2. In advance, email young people (in the 15-18 age group) a link to the Teams/ Zoom meeting and also a copy of T2A Bing Sheets (each page has a different Bingo card and is numbered at the top). Tell them the number of their Bingo card (and record this). They can print it out or just have it on their phone.
3. When you host the online meeting, start with a short, fun icebreaker game.
4. Run the Bingo game by calling out the words in a random order. Chat about each word as you call it out, e.g. "SORTLI... SORTLI – This is a free app that has a bunch of great info when you are on you transition to adulthood journey...SORTLI."
5. The first person to get five in a row wins a prize (give away something fun). You can also check their answers (they tell you their page number in the corner).
6. You may even like to invite someone from Next Step Plus or another service to attend the online Teams activity to share briefly (before the prize is drawn).
7. Young people can have fun and learn about T2A supports and activities.
